

Scheduling & Game Sign-Ups Are Live

Reminders: The email you used to register for Dice Tower West will grant you access to your own personal Dice Tower West portal. There you can manage your badge, purchase merchandise, [access our game scheduling and sign-up system](#), track your library and Play-to-Win checkouts, communicate with other attendees and more. Dice Tower West will be using the Announcement Tab inside your portal to communicate and share important information about the con, so get logged in today so you don't miss out. Make sure you use a good email address when registering and be on the lookout for a confirmation email from CardboardEvents.com with your username and password (check your spam folders).

The Dice Tower Scheduling System has been opened up for games and chat!

Here are your first few tips about scheduling your first games. We will be sharing more over the coming weeks.

1. If you DO NOT want to get notification EMAILS from CardboardEvents.com you will need to turn off notifications (a. click arrow to the right of your name b. click Profile. c. select NO for Notification Emails. NO means you will still get Notifications Flags within the system, but you will no longer get direct Email Notifications.
2. Public Service Announcement. When using the system please remember that this is a family friendly online environment. Please refrain from using inappropriate usernames, offensive language, any kind of rude behavior, etc. DTW reserves the right to remove anyone's online access for inappropriate behavior on any of our interactive systems.
3. Don't overdo it to start. Remember, the convention is more than three months away. We have a lot of demo games, prototype games, shows and specials events still to be scheduled. Out of courtesy to others, we are asking that when hosting/submitting an attendee created game this early, only schedule the games that you are certain you want to get played regardless of what other games/events may come along later. With the convention so far away, please refrain from repeatedly creating and canceling a bunch of games in the system from now until the convention. It's not fair to those that join your game and are disappointed and inconvenienced when you decide to cancel.
4. Always pick a lobby when you schedule/Submit a game. At a minimum you should put your game in the Open Gaming Lobby (attendee created games), but

games can be in more than one Lobby. Lobbies help people both find and discuss relevant themes easier.

5. Since we mentioned lobbies. Help build the community by using them to find and chat about stuff. That's what they are there for. The more they are used, the better the experience will be for everyone.
6. When Submitting/scheduling a game, use the Reserve seat option when you want to save a spot for someone that may not sign up directly on the scheduling system. You can always go back in and unreserve it later if you want.
7. For now, since the Location of the games you Submit may be unknown, you can select Assign Later YES.
8. When you eventually Assign a Location for your game (Assign Later NO), first you will select the room the game is being played in. Next, unless you are running an official event, you will most always select Other Space and free-type in the Directions box where your game can be found (in Section 18E, by the stage, in front of the Arcane Wonders booth, etc.). We ask that you update any Assign Later YES game Locations at least 30 minutes prior to the game's start time so players who joined your game can find it.
9. We've rebuilt this scheduling system from the ground up, so we are sure there will be a few bugs here and there. Please send any bug issues to support@cardboardevents.com so they can be fixed.
